

Help is sought to identify body

SACRAMENTO – Authorities released a forensic sketch Thursday in hopes the public can help identify a man whose skeletal remains were discovered last year.

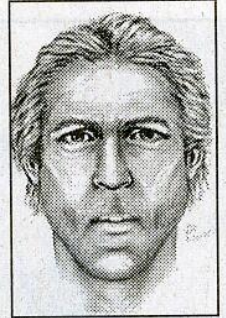
The remains were found June 10 in a densely wooded area north of Interstate 80 near Antelope Road, according to the Sacramento County Coroner's Office. Coroner's officials couldn't identify him through traditional means and sought the help of Barbara Anderson, a forensic artist with the Sacramento Police Department.

The man is believed to have been 32 to 45 years old when he died. He was white, 5-foot-6, plus or minus 3 inches, and had three fractured left ribs and three dental fillings.

He died after being shot in the head, possibly a self-inflicted wound, officials said.
